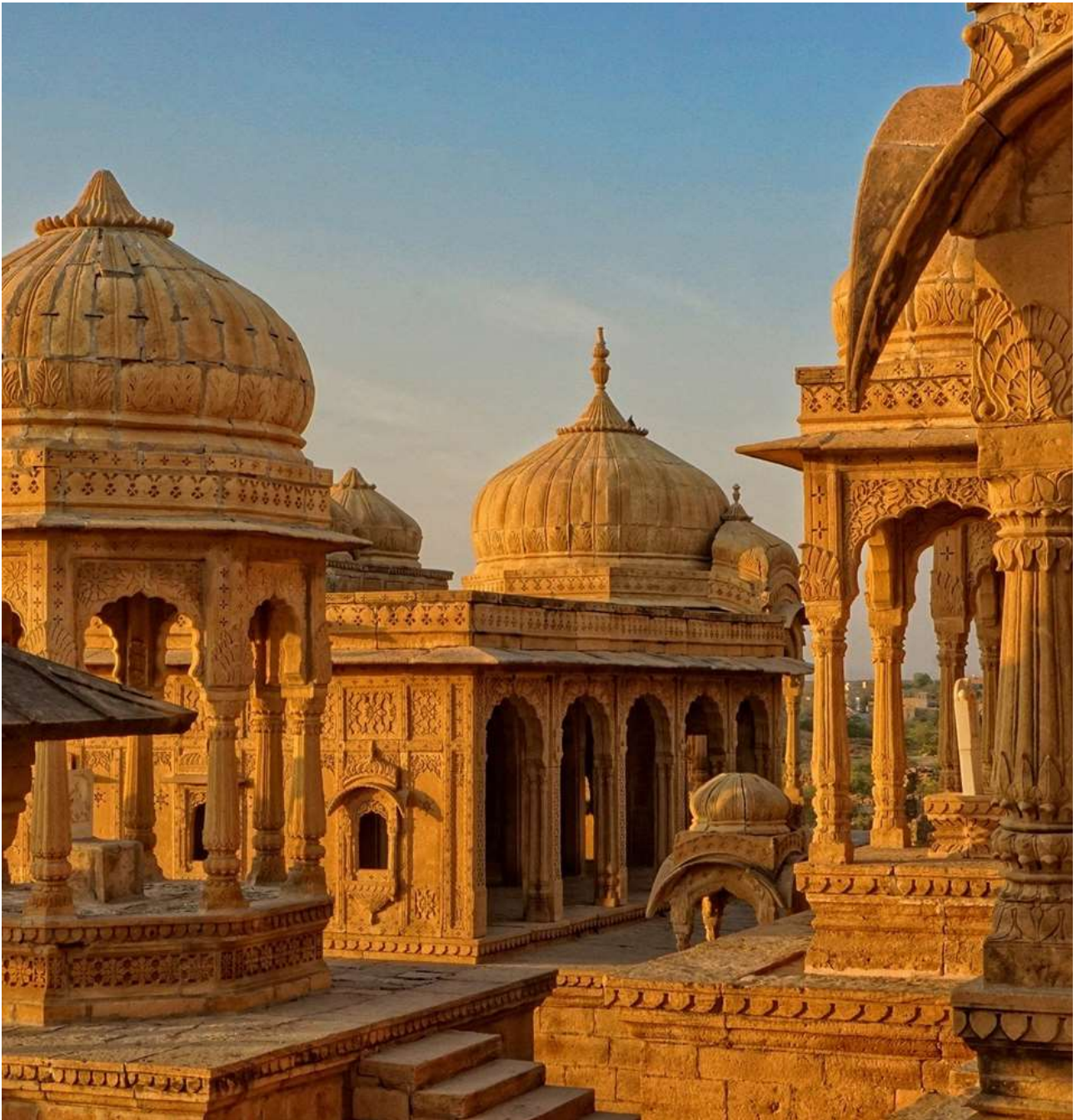

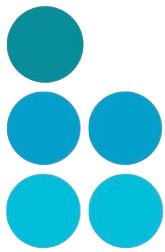

A captivating 13-day itinerary to discover one of the greatest civilisations on our planet, travelling through Rajasthan in a progressive and easy-to-follow way, with a constant balance between the intensity of the programme and real comfort. From the capital Delhi, a necessary gateway to understanding contemporary India and its layers, we enter Rajasthan with a clear transition towards the Thar Desert and its fortress cities.

We reach Jaisalmer, the “Golden City”, carved in yellow sandstone on the edge of the desert, with a fort that is still inhabited and is not only a monument, but a true living urban structure. We continue to Jodhpur, the “Blue City”, dominated by the powerful fortress of Mehrangarh, and then on to Ranakpur, where Jain architecture reaches one of its absolute peaks with the Adinath Temple and its 1,444 columns, each one different. The route continues towards Udaipur, the city of lakes, with palaces and terraces overlooking the water and a slower, more aristocratic atmosphere.

After Udaipur, the journey crosses the epic dimension of Rajput history with Chittorgarh, and the spiritual dimension with Pushkar, a sacred town, compact and suspended around the lake. We then arrive in Jaipur, the “Pink City”, founded in the 18th century according to mathematical and astronomical principles, with Amber Fort, the City Palace, the Jantar Mantar observatory and the iconic Palace of the Winds. The journey ends with Agra, experiencing one of the most intense moments at dawn at the Taj Mahal, before returning to Delhi.

It will be an intense yet orderly route, in which everyday life, history, architecture and landscape alternate coherently. A journey built to leave an indelible memory, and to bring out the most authentic side of the experience and of those who undertake it.

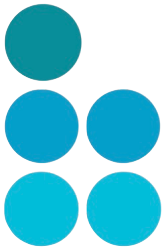

ITINERARY

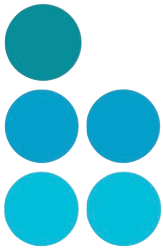
1st DAY MONDAY 31/08 ITALY - DELHI

Departure from Italy to Delhi on an international flight (direct or with a stopover).

2nd DAY TUESDAY 01/09 DELHI

Arrival in Delhi during the night-time hours. Transfer to the hotel and overnight stay.

The day allows a first introductory look at the capital: New Delhi, designed in the colonial era with broad avenues and institutional architecture, and Old

Delhi, denser and more chaotic, made up of markets, alleyways and daily life. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

3rd DAY WEDNESDAY 02/09 DELHI - JAISALMER

Transfer to the airport and a quick domestic flight to Jaisalmer (about 1h40). Effective entry into Rajasthan. Arrival, accommodation in a heritage hotel, first walks through sandstone alleyways, workshops and ancient walls. Dinner and overnight stay.

4th DAY THURSDAY 03/09 JAISALMER

Visit to Jaisalmer Fort (inhabited fort), the palaces and the Jain temples. Visit to the historic havelis. In the afternoon, excursion into the Thar Desert and sunset on the dunes. Dinner and overnight stay.

5th DAY FRIDAY 04/09 JAISALMER - JODHPUR

Overland transfer towards Jodhpur. Arrival in the “Blue City” at the foot of Mehrangarh Fort. Walk in the historic centre and in the market area. Dinner and overnight stay.

6th DAY SATURDAY 05/09 JODHPUR - RANAKPUR - UDAIPUR

Visit to Mehrangarh Fort and Jaswant Thada. Continue towards Ranakpur and visit to the Jain Temple of Adinath (1,444 columns). Arrival in Udaipur in the evening, introductory walk by the lake. Dinner and overnight stay.

7th DAY SUNDAY 06/09 UDAIPUR

Visit to the City Palace and the historic bazaars; artisan workshops and local aesthetic tradition. Sunset on the lake. Dinner and overnight stay.

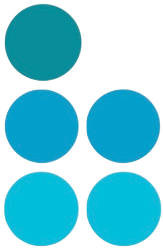
8th DAY MONDAY 07/09 UDAIPUR - CHITTORGARH - PUSHKAR

Departure for Chittorgarh and visit to the fortress (the largest in India). Continue towards Pushkar, a sacred town around the lake attributed to Brahma. Dinner and overnight stay.

9th DAY TUESDAY 08/09 PUSHKAR - JAIPUR

Morning in Pushkar (ghats, central streets). Transfer towards Jaipur and first encounter with the Hawa Mahal. Dinner and overnight stay.

Visit to Amber Fort, City Palace and Jantar Mantar (UNESCO). Jaipur as a synthesis of aesthetics, mathematics, politics and architecture. Dinner and overnight stay.

11th DAY THURSDAY 10/09 JAIPUR - ABHANERI - AGRA

Stop in Abhaneri to visit Chand Baori. Continue towards Agra and arrival in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay.

12th DAY FRIDAY 11/09 AGRA

Visit at dawn to the Taj Mahal and visit to Agra Fort. Time for rest and preparation for the return. Dinner and overnight stay.

13th DAY SATURDAY 12/09 AGRA - DELHI - ITALY

Return to Delhi and international flight back to Italy (in the evening or at night).

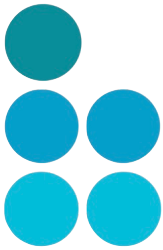

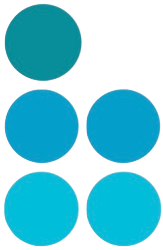

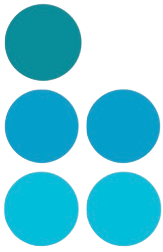
