Meals, mindful eating and ethical policy

Meals included are breakfast and dinner (as per the package). Lunches, however, are not included. Vegetarian and vegan options will be available. Please inform us of such requirements during the pre-booking stage so that we can coordinate with hotels and catering providers.

As regards allergies/intolerances, these must be declared in advance (not on site) to avoid risks and improvisation.

Our trip will be dedicated to the utmost respect for animals and nature: we will not, in fact, offer any activities involving elephants or other forms of animal exploitation. The value of the trip is cultural, human and authentic.

International flights are purchased individually (not included). Coordination is provided (recommended time slot and 2–3 compatible options) to ensure group arrivals and efficient transfers. Proposed airports: Milan Malpensa (MXP) and Rome Fiumicino (FCO).

Deadlines and payment plan (from 24 March 2026)

First information meeting: 24 March 2026

Deadline	What happens
By 8 April 2026 (15 days)	Pre-registration: submission of basic details + room preferences + dietary requirements.
By 23 April 2026	30% deposit: confirm booking and secure hotel/service blocks.
Between 3 May 2026 and 8 May 2026	Flight booking day: coordinated individual selection and purchase (MXP/FCO).
By 23 May 2026	Second instalment of 30% (recommended): payment extension and accounting entry.
By 10 August 2026	Balance of 40%: finalisation of supplier arrangements and final confirmations.

Note: the percentages (30%–30%–40%) constitute the recommended schedule to guarantee seat allocation and operational arrangements. In the event of special requests (individual bookings, late registrations, specific requirements), a personalised schedule may be arranged.
